OCCUPATION:

Every good woman love to see the growth of her family and leaves an inheritance for their children's. That is why the bible says "The wise woman builds her house, but with her own hands, the foolish one tear her's down. She help her husband in building the home by

joining him in tailoring work, treading food stuff in various bush markets, trading dry fish and crayfish in various beach markets. After all the these stress, she settle down and steady in poultry farm business as a result of daily bread, as a good woman that can build her home.


